- ▶ RE leaders have been leading on whole school Virtues projects across the curriculum (in particular RE and RJED)
- ▶ Creating a rich environment which supports our Catholic ethos (RE prayer areas, resource library and adapted planning format)
- ▶ Having an impact which is evident in books, acts of worship, joint teaching, lesson visits, planning support, pupil monitoring, pupil voice and parent views



How will we celebrate pastoral care?
A weekly celebration certificate from each class awarding one pupil as the 'Virtues Champion' of the week. This is someone who has displayed and carried out one of the virtues of either: Faith, Hope, Love, Wisdom, Justice, Courage, Self-control or Joy.

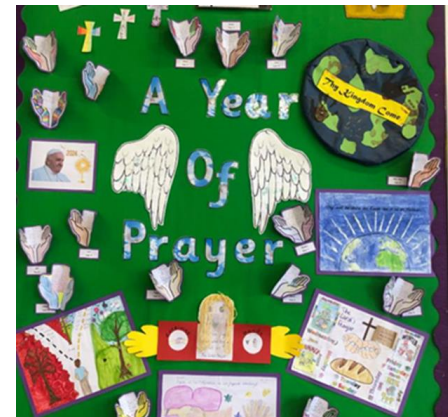

2. Leading and developing Catholic Teaching and Learning



- RE leaders have carried out the implementation of Prayer and Liturgy Directory
- Introduced a Prayer Phase plan of learning across the whole school and for teachers and effectively communicate this to all stakeholders
- RE subject leaders have carried out the implementation of high quality teaching and learning (CPD, lesson visits, team teaching)
- Having an RE lesson first thing on a Monday morning as a core subject and after whole school assembly and then another later in the week.
- Set an agenda for learning by creating a culture of prayer and inspiring our pupils to deepen their faith (Pastoral Time)

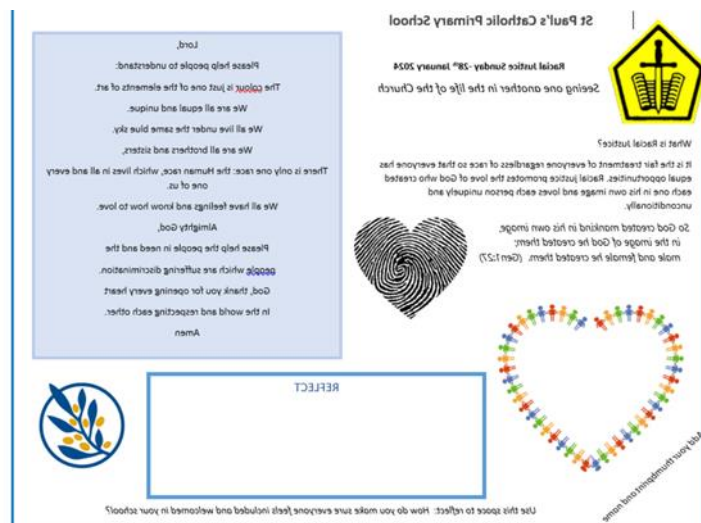

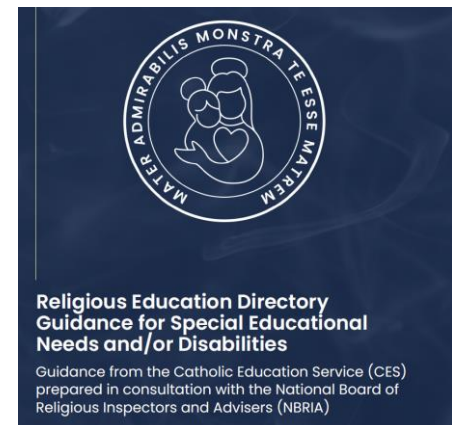
