



Dear Parents/Carers of Year 4 pupils,

This letter highlights the topics we will be covering this half term.

English: In English we will be focussing on the following texts: Until I Met Dudley and Starbird . With each text, children are given the opportunity to explore it using drama, spoken language, reading and the development of grammar through writing. The writing styles that we will be learning about this half term are explanation texts and narratives.

Maths: In Maths, we will be learning about Multiplication and Division, and Measurement and Statistics. This will include learning about factor pairs, integer scaling and correspondence problems, converting units and looking at time graphs.

RE: Our RE unit is 'Prophecy and Promise'. Our Catholic Social Teaching Principle is 'Option for the Poor'

Geography: This term, we will be exploring where our food comes from.

Science: In Science, we are learning about electricity.

DT: In Art, we are learning about nutrition and adapting recipes

PE: PE is on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Tuesday will be forest school so please make sure we have wellies in school. Wednesday will either be swimming or gymnastics.

Computing: In Computing, we are learning about online safety and coding using Scratch.

PSHE: This term we are exploring our feelings and thoughts in the topic 'Celebrating Differences'

French: This term, we will be learning nouns, genders, numbers and adjectives through the topic 'Clothes – getting dressed in France'.
