This letter highlights the topics we will be covering this term.

English:

In English, we will be writing an informal letter and a newspaper report based on the book, 'The true story of the three little pigs'. We will be writing a simile/metaphor poem based on 'The Magic Box'. After half term, we will be basing three pieces of writing around the book 'How to live forever' by Colin Thompson. We will be writing a set of instructions, a persuasive leaflet and a balanced argument.

Maths: In Maths, we will be learning about fractions, multiplication, division, measurement, statistics, geometry, and Roman numerals and negative numbers.

RE: Our two RE units are 'To the end of the Earth' and 'Dialogue and Encounter'. Our Catholic Social Teaching Principle are 'Dignity of Workers' and 'Dignity'.

Geography: This term, we will be exploring the question 'What are rivers and how are they used?'

History: This term, we will be exploring the question 'How did the achievements of the ancient Maya impact their society and beyond?'

Science: In Science, we are learning about 'Classification and changing habitats' and 'Making connections: How does the flow of liquids compare?'

Art: In Art, we are looking at patterns and creating our own based on nature

DT: In DT, we are learning about electrical systems

PE: In PE, we will be learning athletics, handball, cricket and OAA.

Computing: In Computing, we are learning about online safety, computational thinking and data handling.

French: This term, we will be learning about food and music.
