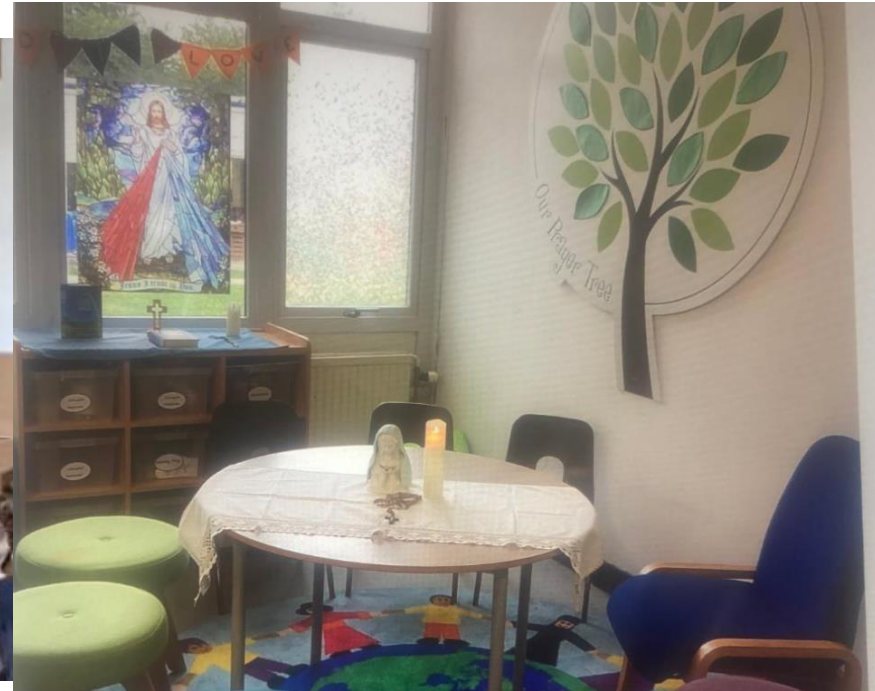

'We read the Bible' Yr1

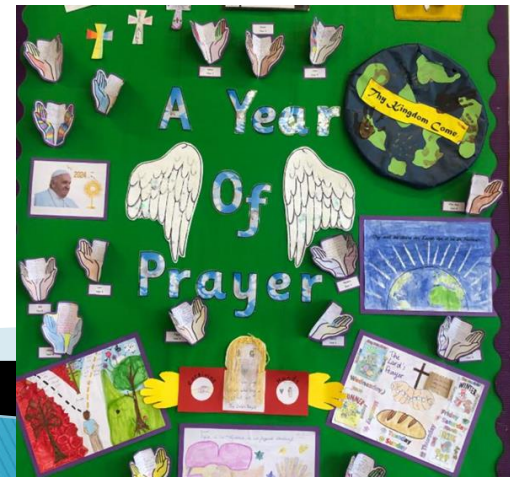
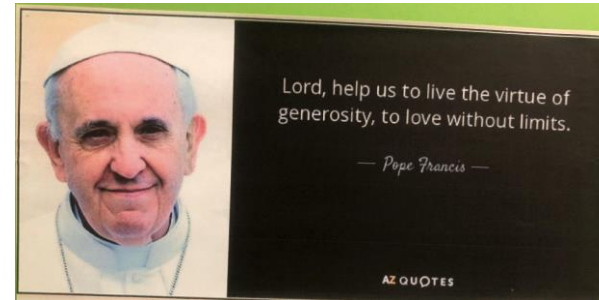
'We pray to Jesus and Mary' Yr2
