We are delighted to share with you the outcome of our recent Catholic School Inspection that took place just before the Easter break, and to celebrate the exceptional achievements of our school community.

The inspection evaluated three key areas: Catholic life and mission, Religious Education and Prayer and Liturgy. Within each area there were 3 sub areas, giving 9 areas for grading overall. We are incredibly proud to report that 7 of these 9 sub areas were graded Outstanding, with the remaining two sub areas receiving a Good rating. This result is the outcome of the dedication, faith, and hard work of our staff, pupils, and families.

The report highlights many of the strengths that make our school a special place to learn and grow. We would like to share a few key findings that reflect the heart of our school ethos:

- **Pupils consistently demonstrate excellent behaviour**, both in lessons and around the school, creating a calm, respectful and positive atmosphere.
- **Warm and supportive relationships** are evident across the school, fostering kindness and mutual respect among pupils.
- **Prayer life is deeply valued by our pupils**, who express their faith with maturity, thoughtfulness, and sincerity.
- The **Catholic life and mission of our school shines through daily**, not only in religious education but across all subjects and in our commitment to care for the poor and vulnerable.
- **Our leadership team is fully committed** to supporting staff, nurturing professional development, and engaging meaningfully with our wider community.

We look forward to proudly sharing our mission within our community, and to continue to develop St Paul's Catholic Primary School. 


partnership we have with you, our parents and carers and parish community. Thank you for your continued support, prayers, and commitment to our school's mission.
