## **Main Barriers to Education**

- Low expectations of parents as to the importance of education
- Parental understanding of the Curriculum
- Historical low expectation for pupils
- Historical poor teaching which did not challenge pupils to achieve.

## **How the school will spend the allocation**

- Paying for advisors to support parents through workshops and information meetings
- Providing opportunities to participate in all activities (e.g, School trips, clubs, residential trips).
- Music lessons to engage pupils and allow access to the wider curriculum
- Teaching assistant support in class for pupils
- Resources (reading books, I pads)
- Cost of releasing staff to ensure teaching is good and outstanding for this group of pupils.
- Cost of releasing staff to observe good practice within the school.

## **How we will measure the impact**

- Percentage of pupils attaining age related and above will increase.
- Percentage of pupils making accelerated progress will increase
- Pupil progress meetings to discuss progress and attainment.
- Teaching will challenge pupils to enable them to move more quickly to close the gap.
- Parents attend workshops and parent consultation evenings.
- Feedback through Parent Working Party and questionnaire will show parental understanding of raised expectations in increasing.
